This was the first This was the first offline session planned by the E-Cell Committee 2021-2022. The speaker for today's event was **Mr. Gautam Jain.** He is a Motivational Speaker and influencer. A webinar on the topic "Communication and Leadership Skills" was held on 7th April 2022 for all the students of the college. The event was for the purpose of motivating students and improving their life and communication skills. The host for the event, Ms. Lekha Ladhe welcomed everyone, briefly expressed the purpose of the seminar, and also welcomed our speaker. Our Director, Dr.(Fr.) John Rose SJ and our Principal Y.D.Venkatesh spoke a few words on the importance of soft skills in a professional world and how we really must be good at selling these skills.

The speaker then started the session by outlining the topics which he would be covering in the section, and also introduced himself. He shared his previous experience and life story, and how we must decide to work hard for the next five years to ensure our future success. He specified how we should prioritize different areas of our lives, and that professional success must come before everything else. He also interacted with the audience and volunteers from FE also participated actively in the session. He emphasized the importance of reason and said that it is the main motivation behind everything.

He then talked about a Stanford experiment, wherein the conclusion was that connections should be proper and that assumptions should be avoided. He also talked about controlling the emotions, and explained the crazy 8 rule for the same. He then moved on to talking about leadership and the rules of leadership. He explained that all leadership starts with self-discipline, and that is where we should begin. Lastly, to conclude the session, he gave us some inspirational messages and finished with a small exercise, showing us that we can always be greater than what we currently are.
